Get creative

Can you create a poster to encourage people to recycle their rubbish?

Get mathematical

For this weeks maths challenge we would like the children to practice some subtraction at home. Ask your child to find 10 items. Once they have their items ask them to choose how many to take away and find how many they have left. Encourage the phrase 10 take away ... equals.

Challenge: Encourage to write the number sentence to go with their work (10 - 3 = 7).

Increase the challenge to 20

You could also practice some doubling too. Encourage the children to add the same amount again to double a number.
